GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Only online application and online payments are allowed.**
2. **Filling up of online application form for admission will start from 26 May 2017 at 12 noon. Online filling up of application form for admission will close on 10 June 2017 at 12 noon.**
3. For online form fill up, please visit the college website : www.vidyamandira.ac.in
4. One may fill up any number of application forms following the eligibility criteria mentioned in the admission norms.
5. Please read the instructions carefully before filling up the forms.
6. **Students must bring their admit card and the copy of online payment receipt (proof of the submission of fees) on the dates of the Admission Test, Viva Voce (if selected after Written Test), date of Admission (if selected after Viva Voce) and on the day of admission to the hostel. If any student fails to show the two documents mentioned above, his candidature will be rejected.**
7. Previous years' questions may be downloaded from the college website www.vidyamandira.ac.in
8. Only regular candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary/equivalent examination in 2017 or 2016 will be eligible to apply.
9. Please note that if any candidate fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned in our admission notice, his candidature will **automatically stand cancelled at any point of the admission process. The college authority will not be responsible for any such cancellation.**
10. Students selected in the written test, must produce all relevant documents in the original during the interview/viva voce failing which their candidature will be cancelled.
11. Candidates must pay the admission charges (college and hostel) through cash/cheque/draft/online mode on the date of the counselling-cum-admission as mentioned in the notification. Fees and charges are printed in the prospectus (also available on the college website) which they will get during the time of written test. Waitlisted candidates

may bring the admission charges on the date they are asked to meet the Principal to know the possibility of their admission. However, this does not guarantee admission in anyway.

12. If any student fails to appear in the process of the counselling-cum-admission, his candidature will be cancelled. Waitlisted candidates too may note that if they fail to come on the specific date and time mentioned for them to meet the Principal for counselling-cum-admission in the vacant seats, their candidature will be cancelled.

 - b. Other Boards (2017 or 2016): Top Four subjects excluding the compulsory

Environmental Studies/ Education.

- **Total marks (theoretical + practical) for lab-based subjects would be taken into account for the subject marks.**

III. DETAILS OF ADMISSION TEST:

1. ENGLISH HONOURS

Selection Procedure:

- Selection will be done purely on the basis of marks obtained in the admission test.
- The admission test will have two parts: **Written Examination** (40 marks) and **Viva Voce** (10 marks).
- The written examination will be of **90 minutes** duration.
- It will have two parts:
 - Part 1: **Grammar**
 - 20 objective type questions of 1 mark each = 20 marks
 - Candidates have to answer the objective type questions first. The answer sheets will be collected from the candidates after 30 minutes.
 - There will be negative marking in the objective type questions round. The following marking pattern will be followed: +1 for correct answers and -0.5 for wrong answers.
 - Part 2: **Comprehension and Composition** (10+10=20 marks).
 - In **Comprehension** (10 marks) candidates will have to read a given prose passage and answer the questions that follow.
 - In **Composition** (10 marks) candidates will have to either express their views on a given topic **OR** write an appreciation of a given poem **OR** write a brief story on a given subject within 300 words approximately.
- In Part 2, i.e. Comprehension and Composition, the answer scripts of only those candidates will be evaluated who secure the requisite cut-off marks determined by the Department after evaluation of Part 1. This cut-off mark will be mentioned in the result of the written test which will be published on the website on the date mentioned in this notification.
- Marks obtained in Part 1 and Part 2 will be combined while short-listing candidates for viva voce.
- The final merit list for admission will be prepared out of the candidates short-listed for viva voce. This merit list will be prepared combining marks obtained in Part 2 of the written test, i.e., Comprehension and Composition (20 marks) and marks obtained in Viva Voce (10 marks).
- Total seats in the subject = 12 (approximately)

2) BENGALI HONOURS

- **Full marks for the written test: 50 (1 hours 15 mts)**
- Candidates will be tested in simple Bengali composition – essay writing, amplification and substance writing.

- There will be an interview of the candidates selected *only* on the basis of the written test.
- **Final selection will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Test (50) + Viva Voce (10) = 60 marks.**
- Total seats in the subject = 15 (approximately)

3) **SANSKRIT HONOURS**

- **Full marks for the written test: 30 (1 hour)**
- Candidates will be tested in simple translation from Bengali/English to Sanskrit; basic Sanskrit grammar, Sanskrit writing skill and common questions on Sanskrit literature.
- There will be a viva voce of the candidates selected *only* on the basis of the written test.
- **Final selection will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Test (30) + Viva Voce (20) = 50 marks.**
- Total seats in the subject = 14 (approximately)

4) **HISTORY HONOURS**

- **Full marks for the written test: 20 (40 mts)**
- Written Examination: Essay (400 words) [in English or Bengali]: Marks 20
- There will be a viva voce of the candidates selected *only* on the basis of the written test (marks 20).
- **Final selection will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Test (20) + Viva Voce (10) = 30 marks.**
- Total seats in the subject = 10 (approximately)

5) **POLITICAL SCIENCE**

- **Full marks for the written test: 20 (40 mts)**
- Question Pattern : 2 questions of 10 marks each (write each within 100 words). It can be written in English / Bengali.
- There will be a viva voce of the candidates selected *only* on the basis of the written test (marks 20).
- **Final selection will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Test (20) + Viva Voce (10) = 30 marks.**
- Total seats in the subject = 10 (approximately)

6) **PHILOSOPHY**

- **Full marks for the test: 20 (40 mts)**
- Essay : 20 marks. It can be written in English / Bengali (maximum word limit 400 words).

- There will be a viva voce of the candidates selected *only* on the basis of the written test (marks 20).
- **Final selection will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Test (20) + Viva Voce (10) = 30 marks.**
- Total seats in the subject = 12 (approximately)

III. DETAILS OF ADMISSION TEST:

PHYSICS HONS:

- a) **Full marks for the written test : 50 (1 hour)**
- b) There shall be 25 questions of 2 marks each covering the whole of H.S [XI & XII] Course and majority of these will be problem-oriented. Appreciable number of questions will be set from XI syllabus also.
- c) A merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured by the student in the **written test**. Students included in this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected. Students may use calculators.
- d) **Final selection will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the Written Test (50) + Viva Voce (10) = 60 marks.**
- e) Total seats in the subject = 24 (approximately)

2) **CHEMISTRY HONS:**

- a) **Full marks for the written test : 50 (1 hour)**
- b) There shall be 25 MCQ type questions of 2 mark each covering the syllabus taught both in class XI and XII standards. There will be no negative marking.
- c) Candidates have to select the correct choice.
- d) *A merit list will be prepared on this basis:* 50 (admission test) + 25 (from aggregate) + 25 (from H.S. Chemistry marks) = 100. The students of this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce as mentioned below. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected.
- e) *The final selection* will be done after adding the viva voce marks (10) to the marks secured as per the details mentioned above.
- f) Total seats in the subject = 26 (approximately)

3) **MATHEMATICS HONS:**

- a) **Full marks for the written test : 50 (1 hour)**
- b) There shall be 25 MCQ type questions covering the syllabus taught both in class XI and XII standards, each carrying 2 marks. For each wrong answer, -1 will be awarded.
- c) Candidates have to select the correct choice. **Calculator is not allowed.**
- d) *A merit list will be prepared on the basis of :*
50 (admission test) + 20 (reduced from H.S. Mathematics) = 70. The students of this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce as mentioned below. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected.
- e) *The final selection* will be done after adding the viva voce marks (30) to the marks secured as per the details mentioned above.
- f) Total seats in the subject = 15 (approximately)

4) **MICROBIOLOGY HONS:**

- a) **Full marks for the written test: 50 (1 hour)**
- b) Syllabus: Entire 10+2 Biology (Class XI and XII)
- c) Number of Questions: 40
- d) Types of Questions:
 - i) MCQ Type: 30 questions each carrying 1 mark
 - ii) Assertion and reasoning Type: 10 questions each carrying 2 marks
- e) Deduction of Marks: One mark will be deducted for two wrong answers
- f) Medium of question: Both English and Bengali
- g) Answer sheet: Put correct option in the respective box
- e) Candidate may carry own calculator in the examination hall Total seats in the subject = 16 (approximately)

5) **ZOOLOGY HONS:**

- a) **Full marks for the written test: 50 (1 hour)**
- b) There shall be two types of questions: (a) 25 MCQ each of 2 marks. These questions will cover the **entire syllabus** taught in both class XI and XII
- c) Negative Marking- at the rate of -1 for each wrong answer.
- d) *A preliminary merit list will be prepared on this basis: 50 (admission test) + 20 (reduced from H.S. Chemistry marks) + 20 (reduced from H.S. Biology) = 90. The students of this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected.*
- e) *The final selection will be done after adding the viva voce marks (10) to the marks secured as per the details mentioned above.*
- f) Total seats in the subject = 16 (approximately)

5) **COMPUTER SCIENCE HONS:**

- a) **Full marks of the written test : 50 (1 hour)**
- b) There shall be 25 MCQ questions of 2 marks each, covering Mathematics syllabus taught both in XI and XII standard. Each wrong answer will result in (-1). Calculator is not allowed. Rough work should be done in the limited space provided.
- c) Candidates have to select the correct choice.
- d) There will be an interview of the candidates preliminarily selected *only* on the basis of the written test. The students of this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce as mentioned below. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected.
- e) *The final selection will be done on the basis of the marks secured in the written test (50) + viva voce (10)=60.*
- f) Total seats in the subject = 16 (approximately)

6) **INDUSTRIAL CHEMISTRY HONS:**

- a) **Full marks for the written test : 50 (1 hour)**
- b) There shall be 25 MCQ type questions each carrying 2 marks covering Chemistry syllabus taught both in class XI and XII standards. Each wrong answer will result in (-1). Rough work should be done in the limited space provided.
- c) Candidates have to select the correct choice.
- d) *A merit list will be prepared on this basis: 50 (admission test) + 25 (from aggregate) + 25 (from H.S. Chemistry marks) = 100. The students of this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce as mentioned below. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected.*
- e) *The final selection will be done after adding the viva voce marks (10) to the marks secured as per the details mentioned above.*
- f) Total seats in the subject = 15 (approximately)

7) **ECONOMICS HONS:**

- a) **Full marks for the written test : 50 (1 hour 30 mts)**
- b) Candidates will be tested in [Higher Secondary] Mathematics (30) and English (essay writing) (20) = 50 marks.
- c) *A preliminary merit list will be prepared on this basis: 50 (admission test) + 50 (reduced from H.S. aggregate) = 100. The students of this merit list will have to appear in a viva voce as mentioned below. The students who will remain absent in the viva will be summarily rejected.*
- d) *The final selection will be done on the following basis : 50 (admission test) + 50 (reduced from H.S. aggregate)+ Viva voce (25) = 125*
- e) Total seats in the subject = 10 (approximately)
